(There are too many people here.)

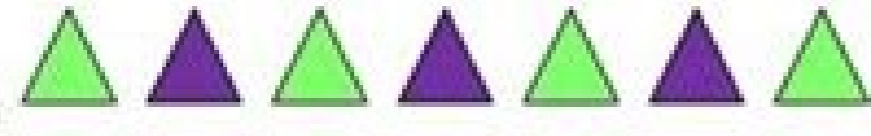
